

**Minutes of 2010 Implantology Research Group Business Meeting**  
**IADR Annual Session, Barcelona Spain**  
**Thursday July 15, 2010 Barcelona CCIB Rm115**

Meeting started at 5:00PM. Executive Committee members present were: Hosokawa, Shin, Pamuk, Mitchell, Stanford, Duyck, Leblebicioglu, Romanos, and Ucar. Absent were Keller and Heo.

The annual group business meeting was held on Thursday July 15, 2010 in Barcelona CCIB (Rm115). Professor Ryuji Hosokawa presided as group President. There were about 60 people in attendance at the business meeting.

The agenda was reviewed and accepted by the group.

**Councilor's Report:** Reports were made by Dr. John Mitchell regarding the financial report, membership report, and IADR Council meeting. Summary comments were made. These comments include that the organization is financially doing well with the Barcelona meeting. There is also concern about the number of withdrawn papers.

**Financial Report:** A Report was made by Drs. John Mitchell/Clark Stanford. Current balance (as of 7-14-2010) is **\$39,364.44**. In 2009/2010 dues were \$15(pre-tax) with \$11/regular member going to the group (\$1 tax increase from 2009). Fund balance as of last annual report was \$35,651.19 (Washington AADR 3/2010). Total income for the year was \$3928 (for 2010) and expenditure was \$214.75. NobelBiocare provided a gift for the research prize of \$4980 for 2008 and again \$4980 for the 2009 Young Investigator Fellowship program, however no special donation for the 2010 Barcelona meeting. A donation from **Panasonic** for the joint Prosthodontic group and IRG reception was provided that covered the entire costs of the Barcelona reception.

**2010 AADR (Washington DC, March 3-6, 2010) Report:** A report was made by Drs. Shin/Pamuk At the 2010 AADR meeting, the IRG cosponsored one symposium (Reconstructive Dentistry and Tissue Engineering), 2 L&L sessions and sequenced 2 Oral Sessions (12 papers, 1 withdrawn) and 2 poster sessions (39 papers and 1 withdrawn).

**Program Chair Report: A report** was made by Drs. Shin/Pamuk. At the 2010 IADR meeting, the IRG co-sponsored two symposia, two L&L sessions and two keynote addresses. The IRG sequenced 10 Oral Sessions and 15 poster (including one poster discussion) sessions. By comparison, the 2009 Miami IADR meeting had 6 Oral Sessions and 7 Poster sessions. The number of IRG-handled papers are almost twice as much as previous meeting. There were 58 oral papers accepted but 1 withdraw (1.8 % withdrawal rate), whereas 257 poster presentations were accepted but 16 withdraws (5.4 % withdrawal rate).

**Symposium Report** was made by Dr. Selim Pamuk. There was no symposium organized by the IRG. Two symposia were co-sponsored by the groups at the 2010 IADR meeting. First symposium on Functionalized Biomaterials for Prosthetic and Reconstructive Dentistry was held on Thursday, July 15, 2010. This was co-sponsored by Dental Materials, Implantology Research, Mineralized Tissue, Periodontal Research, Prosthodontics Research Second symposium on Dental Implants as Delivery Devices for Drugs and Growth Factors held on Saturday, July 17, 2010. This was co-sponsored by Craniofacial Biology, Implantology Research, Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery.

**Lunch and Learning Report** was made by Dr. Binnaz Leblebicioglu. Two L&L sessions were provided.

First Lunch and Learning on Current Trends on Endosseous Implant Bulk and Surface Design was held By P.G. COELHO, New York University, New York, NY on Thursday, July 15, 2010.  
Second Lunch and Learning on the Effects of Time-to-loading of Implants on Treatment Outcomes was held by A. JOKSTAD, University of Toronto, Toronto, ON, Canada on Friday, July 16, 2010.

**Awards Report** was made by Drs. Duyck/Pamuk.
